#### 7.3 Institutional Distinctiveness-

The Institute established in 1993 (completed 25 years), run by the Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj, Nashik which is well-known institute in Maharashtra and affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. Its mission is to provide quality education to all by means of sheer hard work, dedication and devotion. In 2016-17, the college was reaccriditated with "A" with CGPA 3.20 status by NAAC, Bangalore. The college is awarded as a "Best College" in 2013-14.

It has been over 106 years that it has stood the test of time to become legend of unparalleled stature. It always maintains social awareness and social commitment through various activities. It has shown active participation in all socially sensitive issues. The motto of the Samaj reads for the "Wellbeing and Happiness of the Masses" to kindle the social cause.

The institute always concentrates on students' qualitative performance along with their overall personality development. The institute motivates girls and boys for their social responsibilities. Various gender sensitization programmes were organised by different committees in the college to bring out the overall development of girls and boys and thereby to mould a better society with equality.

The Institute has taken initiatives to make awareness among the society about the Gender Equality, Gender Sensitisation, Third Gender etc through the yearly magazine on "Transgender". Published a special issue on Gender Sensitization on the hands of Third Gender Sanjana Mahale. The national conference on Gender Sensitization: Special Reference to Third Gender was organized in college Aims and Objectives of the conference were to focus on education for third gender to create employment, to sensitize minds of people to accept third gender as a part of our society and to become familiar with the National and International legal frame work for gender quality. The Mother Institute formed a committee for third genders social and educational awareness. Mother institute assigned all responsibilities regarding third gender committee to the College.

On the occasion of National Sports Day institute arranged Blood Donation Camp at the Dr. Vasantrao Pawar Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Adgaon Nashik and achieved 1 <sup>st</sup> prize. Department of physical education & sports jointly organized Blood Donation Camp for the benefits of the society three times in the year.

Mother Institute every year organizes Medical Health Check-up Camp for U.G. and P.G. students. It has been carried out in collaboration with Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj's Dr Vasantrao Pawar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Nashik. A free check-up camp has been organised by our college and doctors of various specializations invited for consultation. College forms Discipline Committee for maintaining Discipline in the campus.

The department of Psychology created awareness of mental health issues on occasion of Mental Health Day. During Covid-19 pandemic period Psychology Department conducted online National survey and free telephonic counseling

Institute has adopted five villages namely Girnare, Gangavhare, Pimplad- nasik, Chandashi and Pegalwadi Trymbak Dist. Nashik for socioeconomic development under "Unnat Bharat Abhiyan" (UBA) of HRDC New Dehli. The Institute established UBA Cell in the year 2018, for social, economical, educational, health and cultural development of villages. Faculty members and students involved in social activities and are engaged in several community development activities.

NSS organized winter camp at Girnare village near Nashik city in which Socio-Economic and Health Survey of village conducted. Cleanliness, Tree plantation and create awareness among villagers of Girnare. Students actively participated in Swachha Bharat Abhiyan Pandherwada. Screening of Anaemia in rural women by haemoglobin estimation camp and blood donation camp at Girnare had been carried out in collaboration with MVP's Dr Vasantrao Pawar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Nashik.

Under the activity of eco-friendly Ganesh Festival Lord Ganesh Statues were collected by faculty members and students and handed them over to Nashik Municipal Corporation and saved Nandini river from pollution. Students from the college worked as volunteers at Navratri festival and controlled the crowd. They also worked as a volunteer in Assembly election, students from B.Voc (Electrical) department look after Electrical maintenance of institute The Vishakha Guidelines are a set of procedural guidelines for use in India in cases of sexual harassment. The college enthusiastically provides student oriented schemes for their upliftment and empowerment. "The Earn and Learn Scheme" was started for economically weak students. The selection is made through proper procedure- inviting applications- scrutinizing them – and interview. The payment is given as per clock hour basis.

Special feature of this year is Manakarnika Award which has been given to motivate the girl student of every department who were struggling for their livelihood and taking education in worst economical condition and were successful in education also.

. The college has NCC unit only for girls. The NCC unit for girls provides a suitable environment for taking up a career in the armed forces. Gymkhana department is very active. It motivates students to participate in various indoor and outdoor games. Yoga training is given to students and teachers every year.

Reading festivals and book exhibitions were arranged under the initiative of the library. In the year 2019-20 book exhibition on gender sensitization was organized by the library. All three genders related books and writers' books were displayed in exhibition.

The College Library has done International MoU with the Kusumagraj Pratishthan for "Granth Tumchya Dari" Service to improve the reading habits among staff & Students, Strengthen the library collection and make available books to the stakeholders. The Kusumagraj Pratishthan Issue a Box of 100 books to the college library for 4 months. College Library issue these books to the readers without charging any kind of fee. After 4 months the Kusumagaj Pratishthan Update this box of 100 books they give another 100 books to the college library. Also distributed books into adapted village Girnare under the scheme Granth Tumachyadari and made available the books to the students and people of Girnare village.

Institute celebrated International Yoga day on 21<sup>st</sup> June to inculcate importance of Yoga among the students. 'Voter awareness programme' creates awareness in the people at state and District level. Institute arranged AIDS awareness rally, Fit India movement program for the health awareness among staff, students & society, values and spiritual education for staff and students in collaboration with 'Prajapita Bramhakumari', Organ donation awareness rally to aware the people about the need of organ donation and to remove the hesitations of the people about donating organs. Lokmat mahamarathon off campus for health awareness of the society, Savidhan Sanman Saptah was celebrated to promote study and education about the Indian Constitution. Institute implemented Swachha Bharat Abhiyan on the occassion of Mahatma Gandhi Birth Anniversary.

Institute runs Janshikshan Sanstha Courses for self-employment. 'Beauty culture and Health Care' training course conducted for Third Gender in collaboration with Manmilan Bahuuddeshiya Samajik Sanstha Nashik and Jan Shikshan Sanstha. For blind students (Divyang) institute provides Audio CD's, Screen reader software and Magazine in brail script. Teaching, Non-teaching Staff and Students contributed fund for 'Student personality development' 20 quintals Grain collected by teaching, non-teaching staff and students of the college and donated to economically poor students and Covid-19 Suffered People. Special feature of this year is Cultural Programme based on theme on Farmers and felicitation of two Farmers of Nashik District. Our Institute donated four Bicycles, and three tricycle to Handicap students. Even though ours' is a traditional college, students' career needs were looked by training and placement cell. Students were equipped with those skills which were necessary for them to be competent in global market
