The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case any action is taken against FINSERV by any such tax authority in respect of conduct of CPBFI by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.
- xvi. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the information specified in Annexure 3 before commencement of every batch to FINSERV.





#### 4. Batch Strength:

The parties agree that, each batch shall consist of minimum 45 and maximum (i) students. FMSERV and the PARTMEN INSTITUTE may mutually decide to start a batch with less than 45 students.

#### 5. Term of the MOU

The term of this MOU is for a period commencing from signing of this MoU till end of March 31, 2024, except Clause 3(sin) and Clause 14, which shall continue to be in force for a further period of 3 years from the date of termination of the MOU. The parties may decide to further extend the term of this MOU by mutual content on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between them.

### 6. Course fees

- PARTNER INSTITUTE shall charge a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1,000 (Rupees One Thousand only) plus applicable GST and other taxes, to each of the students of CPBFI towards the course fees. The fee payable by each student shall not be less than Rs. 1,000 (Rupees one thousand only) plus applicable taxes and shall not exceed Rs. 3,000 (Rupees three thousand) plus applicable taxes. The fees specified here shall be valid for two years from signing of this MOU. The fees shall be reviewed on completion of this period and parties may mutually agree to revise the same from time to time.
- Consuccessful completion of every batch (i.e. if the overall attendance of the students is in excess of 75%) of CPBTI-CLASSROOM and CPBTI-BLENDED, FINSERV shall pay an amount of Rs. S00 (Rupees five Hundred only) per student to the PARTNER INSTITUTE as a fee subsidy. The fee subsidy shall be paid by FINSERV within 2 weeks from completion of every batch and submission of bank account information as per Annexure 3. The method for calculating the overall attendance in respect of CPBFI batches, is included in Annexure 2.
- The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to suitably remunerate the coordinator and other staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of CPBFI Batch.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE, may at its own discretion, waive the fees of students from economically weaker sections, provided the number of such students does not exceed 15% of total enrolment in the respective batch.
- The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure that no student shall be allowed to attend CPBH without paying the full fees except those permitted under sub-clause in above.
- VI. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit to FINSERV, before commercement of any batch, extracts of bank statement or copies of cash receipts or a letter from the Principal or Vice-Principal confirming collection of fees from every participant.

# /. Duration and contents of CPBFI:

- CPBFs will involve training of about 100 hours.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to mobilize, on best effort basis, at least 40 students in first academic year and at least 80 students from second academic year cowards. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall decide the batch schedule and timings and inform the schedule to FINSERV at least 45 days before commencement of the batch.
- III. FINSERV shall arrange to make the faculty available as per the schedule informed by the PARTNER INSTITUTE





 Detailed schedule of the lectures and practical shall be given in advance to students before commencement of cross.

#### & Place of tracting

The CPBH class room tracking and practical shall be conducted at Karmaveer Shantarambapu Kondaji Wavare Arts, Science and Commerce College (CIDCO College), Nashik by the CPBH Official Training Partner, for up to four hours a day on such days, dates and at such timings as may be mutually decided between the parties.

#### 9. (Applicity for CPBF):

- Any student who is studying in the final year of Graduation Programme or pursuing any post-graduation programme shall be eligible to apply for admission to CPBFI.
- Additionally, any fresh graduate i.e. a graduate with less than 2 years of work experience or no work experience, shall also be eligible to apply for admission to CPBFI.
- Only candidates who are less than 27 years old, on the date of application, are eligible to apply for admission to CPRFI.
- W. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall select the final list of candidates for admission-based on the criteria mutually agreed upon by the PARTNER INSTITUTE and FINSERV from time to time.

#### 10. Discipline and right to expel-

- The students of CPBFI-CLASSRODM and CPBFI-BLENDED shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct
  of the PARTNER INSTITUTE during course period. In case of CPBFI ONLINE, the students shall be subject to rules
  of discipline/code of conduct of the CPBFI Official Training Partner.
- If the concerned CPBFI Official Training Partner observes a breach of code of conduct by any student, it shall immediately report the same to the CPBFI Coordinator for necessary action.
- If any participant commits breach of code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, the faculty shall have full authority to expel such student for the remaining duration of CPBFI.

#### 11. Faculty:

- FINSERV shall be sofely responsible for arranging, through a CPBFI Official Training Partner, faculty, with requisite
  industry and teaching experience, and conducting CPBFI efficiently and effectively. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall
  not be responsible for making any payments to the faculty of the CPBFI Official Training Partner.
- i. Some of the lectures of CPBFI may be conducted by the experts from FINSERV as per the understanding between the parties. However, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be liable to pay any amounts to FINSERV towards the said lectures and no amounts shall be deducted from the amounts payable to the PARTNER INSTITUTE.





#### 17 Certification:

PINSERY and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" in "Certificate Programme is flurieurg, Finance and Insurance" to the eligible students of CPUFI CLASSROOM and CPUFI BLENDED. The certificates shall be printed by FINSERY and shall carry the logos of FINSERY, the PARTNER INSTITUTE and the concerned CPBFI CPM-coal Training Partner.

FINSERY shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" in "Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance" to the eligible students of CPBH-ONLINE. The certificates shall be an digital format and shall carry the logos of FINSERY, the PARTINER INSTITUTE and the concerned CPBH Training Partiner.

#### 13 Further Agreements:

The parties agree that, they may mutually discuss and enter into further agreements, if needed.

#### 14 Confidentialox

- The Parties agree to maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality regarding any and all Confidential Information
  exchanged or to be exchanged between them in relation to this MOU.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that all the course material provided by FINSERV or the CPBFI Official Training Partner, including but not limited to CPBFI structure, curriculum, lesson plans and evaluation methods, shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.
- III. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that any of FINSERV's technical or business or other information including information given for development of any case studies / development of any program modules / contents, made available by FINSERV or its personnel to the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to restrict access and disclosure of Confidential Information to such of their employees, agents, vendors, and contractors strictly on a "need to know" basis, to maintain confidentiality of the Information disclosed to it in accordance with this clause.
- v Information and material disclosed and provided by each party to the other party in pursuance of or in connection with performance of its obligation under this MOU shall, at all times, remain the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing Party.

#### Intimation about cancellation/postponement of CPBF):

- If due to any cogent reasons, it appears to the PARTNER INSTITUTE that it is unable to orrange any batch as per schedule, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate about its inability to FINSERV at loast 30 days in advance and the parties shall decide further schedule of CPBFI by mutual consent. FINSERV may decide to complete such batches through online classes.
- ii. However, if such postponement or cancellation is necessitated due to any last minute, unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances like Act of God, civil commotion, strike, bandh, disruption of traffic, epidemic, war, aggression, change in Government Policy or any other similar circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate the change in schedule as early as possible after such circumstances as stated above have arisen. In such circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be held liable for payment towards any loss or damages caused to FINSERV due to delay in its schedule.





If for any reason, FINSERV, decides to discontinue support for CPBFL it shall give a written notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, 30 days in advance. Such notice shall not impact any hatch which is already in progress on the date of notice and the terms of this MOU shall continue to apply to the running batches.

#### 16. Amendment/Termination:

- Any amendment to the terms of this MOU can only be made by mutual consent of the parties.
- This MOU may be terminated by either party, for breach of terms and conditions of the present MOU or otherwise, by a written notice of at least one (1) month in advance. Such notice of termination shall not interfere with the batches underway at the relevant time. Such batches shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.
- Both the parties agree that Finsery shall have the right of terminating this MOU without any notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, if the PARTNER INSTITUTE charges 4 fee exceeding the amount prescribed under Clause 6(ii) of this MOLL in such event, the batches underway at the relevant time, may also be terminated by FINSERV. unless the PARTNER INSTITUTE refunds the excess fee charged to every student of the batch.

#### 17. Applicable Law and Dispute Settlement:

- This MOU shall be governed by the Laws of India.
- Any dispute arising between the parties in connection with or arising out of the performance of mutual H. obligations under this MOU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and consultation. If the dispute remained unresolved even after 30 days, then the dispute shall be referred to the Principal of Karmaveer Shantarambapu Kondaji Wavare Arts, Science and Commerce College (CIDCO College) and Mr. V. Rajagopalan, President (Legal and Taxation), Bajaj Finsery Limited. The decision of the Principal of Karmaveer Shantarambapu Kondaji Wavare Arts, Science and Commerce College (CIDCO College) and Mr. Rajagopalan shall be final and binding on both parties.

#### 18. Originals:

This MOU is executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be original and retained by each of the Parties. but together they shall constitute one and the same MOU.

### Annexure 2: Methodology for Calculating Overall Attendance of the Batch

The steps and formula for calculating overall attendance are as under.

- 1. Enrollment: Number of students who have registered and paid fees for CPSFI
- 2. Drop outs: Number of students who stopped attending CPBFI during the batch
- 3. Regular students: Enrollment minus Drop Dut
- Total available student days: Number of regular students multiplied by total duration of CPBFI (number of days, E.g. 40 days)
- 5. Actual student days: Sum of days attended by each regular student.
- 6. Overall attendance (%) = Actual Student Days / Available Student Days X 100

Example: In a CPBFI batch 43 students registered and paid fees. By end of first week 3 students stopped attending the batch. The batch was conducted for 40 days. Out of the 40 regular students – 10 attended every class, 15 attended for 35 days, 10 attended for 33 days and 5 attended by 30 days. Overall attendance will be calculated as under.

Available days: 40 X 40 i.e. 1500

Actual days: (10 X 40) + (15 X 35) + (10 X 33) + (5 X 30) - 400 + 525 + 330 + 150 - 1405

This Agreement is made on the 16th day of January 2019 between DELNET-Developing Library Network, JNU Campus, Nelson Mandela Road, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi-110070 (hereinafter referred to as DELNET) and M.V.P. Samaj's, K.S.K.W. Arts, Science & Commerce College, CIDCO, Nashik-422008.

(with full address)

(Hereinafter referred to as the 'Institutional Member')

Whereas DELNET has agreed to grant non-exclusive license to the Institutional Member to use DELNET's Archives and Services, Union Catalogues and other databases online, provide technical guidance in database creation and networking and deliver to the Institutional Member from time to time any computer programmes and to grant a non-exclusive license to use such programmes and their associated documents on the terms and conditions hereinafter contained:

Whereas the Institutional Member has its library located at M.V.P. Samaj's K.S.K.W. Arts, Science & Commerce College, CIDCO, Uttamnagar, Nashik (MS) 422008 and has agreed to become a member of DELNET to use DELNET archives and services at this location only and promote and share its library resources with other institutional members of DELNET: -

Now it is hereby agreed as follows:

### The Institutional Member shall:

- Use the DELNET databases for furthering its own research programmes and providing information to its users and Institutional Members of DELNET.
- Use the software arranged by or through DELNET, if desired by the Institutional Member, on the machine owned by the Institutional Member at the above location.
- Create records using international standards as adopted by DELNET from time to time (DELNET is recommending the creation of records using MARC, AACR II, the Library of Congress Subject Headings List and specialised thesauri, but libraries that have used other standards can still join DELNET and upgrade their records in due course of time).
- 4. Contribute the records of all items created by the Institutional Member to the Central Union Catalogues, Union Lists, etc. maintained by DELNET. The copyright of records created by the Institutional Member in its own machine will rest in the Institutional Member, but the copyright of the Central Union Catalogues shall rest in DELNET.
- Pay an initial registration fee of Rs.5,000 + 18% GST to DELNET towards its Corpus Fund.
- 6. Pay Annual Membership Fee to DELNET for the use of its online resources and services at rates set by DELNET annually in advance on or before 1<sup>st</sup> April or the date of expiry of membership. (If membership dues for the applicable membership year are not received on or before the date of expiry of the current membership, a grace period of one month will be given, after which services will be temporarily suspended. The services will be started immediately after the receipt of annual payment within the following year. If the annual membership fee is not paid within one year of the date of expiry, the membership will stand cancelled. If the institution wants to use DELNET services again, the institutions will have to apply afresh and pay admission fee and annual membership fee payable by an Institutional Member at present is Rs.11,500 + 18% GST).
- Pay all fees charges within thirty days from the date of DELNET invoice. The Institutional Member shall pay interest on all amounts not paid on the due date at the rate of 10% from the date of invoice to the date of payment.

The Institutional Member shall not:

- Use the DELNET Union Catalogues, Union Lists and other databases for any commercial purpose. The Institutional Member shall not rent, sell or license the use of or deliver or release or otherwise part with the possession of the systems/materials/software or the DELNET Union Catalogues, Union Lists and databases or any part thereof to any third person.

### It is further agreed that:

In such a case, the Institutional Member shall stop the use of the DELNET system facilities and databases with immediate effect and return any software/hardware provided by or through DELNET back to DELNET. All disputes between the parties shall be settled by negotiation.
