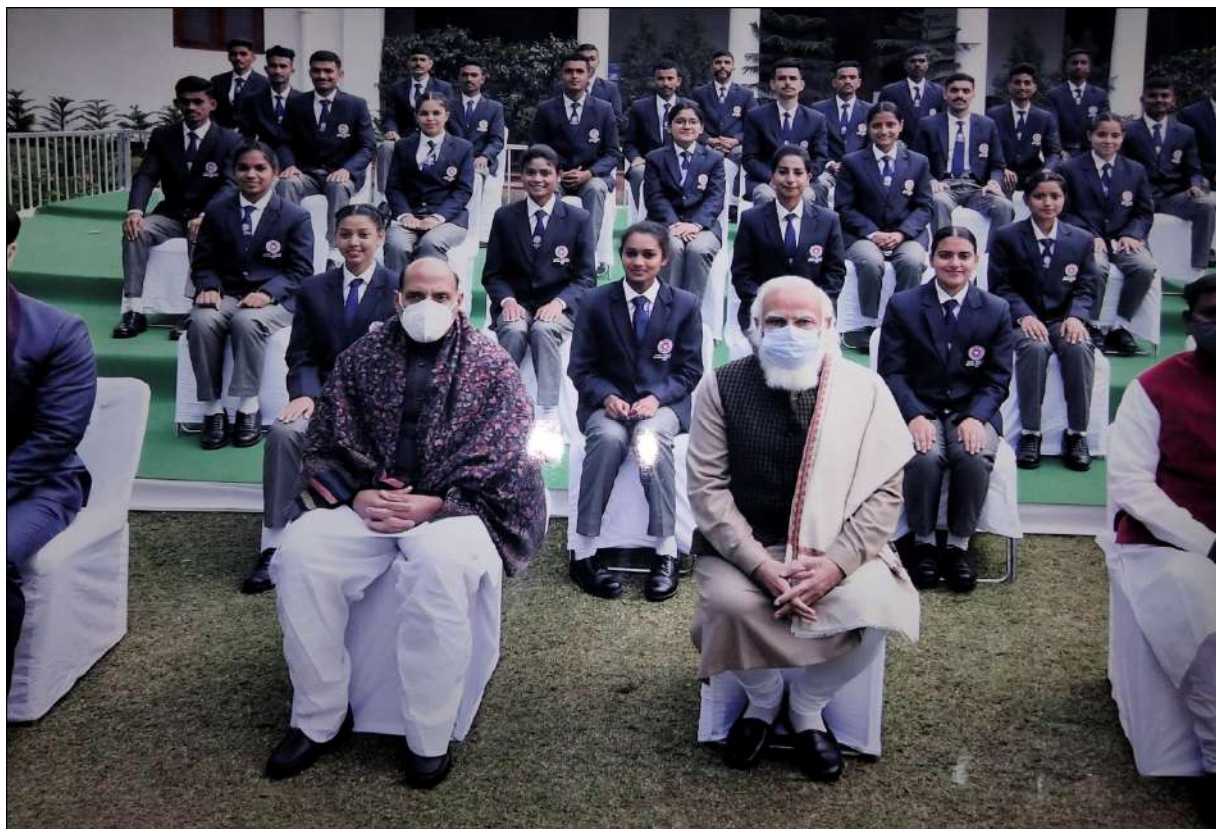

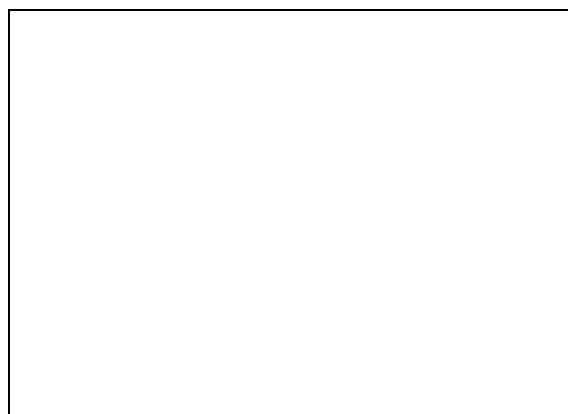

### Grain Donation Programme Report (2018-19)

#### Hunger problem in India:

Millions of people around the world are simply too poor to be **able** to buy food. They also **lack** the resources to grow their own food. There are many causes of **poverty** that contribute to the problem of world hunger. Hunger does not exploit only the body, it also affects the brain.

**Global Hunger Index:** GHI scores are based on four indicators:

- **UNDERNOURISHMENT:** the share of the population that is undernourished (that is, whose caloric intake is insufficient)
- **CHILD WASTING:** the share of children under the age of five who are wasted (that is, who have low weight for their height, reflecting acute undernutrition)
- **CHILD STUNTING:** the share of children under the age of five who are stunted (that is, who have low height for their age, reflecting chronic undernutrition)
- **CHILD MORTALITY:** the mortality rate of children under the age of five (in part, a reflection of the fatal mix of inadequate nutrition and unhealthy environments)

The Global Hunger Index (GHI) is designed to comprehensively measure and track hunger globally and by country and region. The International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) calculates GHI scores each year to assess progress and setbacks in combating hunger.

Despite the good economic performance, with over 200 million (20 Cr) people who are food insecure i.e Over **20 crore** Indians will sleep hungry tonight. India is home to the largest number of hungry people in the world.

In the ranking of the Global Hunger Index 2017 it covers position 100 out of 119 ranked countries and has an "serious" (31.4) food security situation. (Source: Global Hunger Index 2017 & 2014 Reports)

The major problem in the country is the high prevalence of underweight children under five, which is a result of low nutrition and educational status of women. Over **7000** Indians die of hunger every day. Over **25 lakh** Indians die of hunger every year.

**India does produce enough food.** Hunger exists in India because of uncaring about storage, wastage, distribution and mass affordability of food. According to the report in the journal, up to 40 % (**Rs 50,000 crore**) of the food produced in India is bound to get **wasted** and never reaches the needy every year in the country.

#### India's initiatives to tackle Malnutrition:

In recent times, India has taken several measures to tackle malnutrition of children and mothers. Some of the important measures are as follows:

NITI Aayog in consultation with stakeholders has formulated and released National Nutrition Strategy emphasizing importance on interdepartmental convergence, setting up clear targets and real time monitoring.



113 most backward districts (on nutrition parameters) have been identified for taking up action in mission mode.

**College Initiative in Grain Collection:**

Principal of Karmaveer Shantarambpu Kondaji Wavre , Arts Science And Commerce College, Uttamnagar CIDCO, Nashik has taken initiative in this regard. Principal of our college explained the vision and motto of "Grain Donation Programme" in the staff meeting. Principal also addressed the students of the college.


